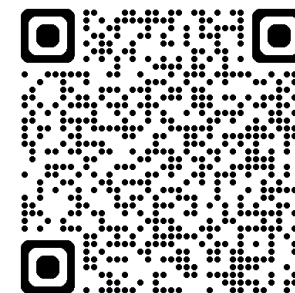


THE NAVY LEAGUE OF CANADA YOUTH PROGRAMS
